»Dogodivščina med kraškimi polji« Spoznavajmo in
raziskujmo območja klasičnega krasa, ki je po svojih
posebnostih znan po celi svetu.

Notranjska, del klasičnega krasa

Notranjska je dežela visokih planot, hribov ter polij. Območje med Loškim in Cerkniškim poljem je tipično prehodno območje med požiralnim delom enega polja ter izvirnim delom drugega. Potok Obrh na Loškem polju ponikne v številne požiralnice, ob višjih vodah tudi skozi 2 vhoda v podzemno jamo Golobino. Na drugi strani, v okolici kraških izvirov Cemun in Obrh, se na Cerkniškem polju zadržujejo številne divje živali in rastejo posebne rastline, prilagojene na prehod med vodo in suhim travnikom.

Izhodišče: Dobimo se pred cerkvijo sv. Urbana na Škrilah (vas Dane), občina Loška dolina

Kdaj: PONEDELJEK, 12.9.2022 ob 9.00 uri

Dolžina (km): peš: **6 km**, vožnja z avtomobilom: **3 km**

Trajanje: peš hoja po Loškem polju in ogled vhodov v jamo Golobino: 1 ura 15 minut, peš hoja po Cerkniškem polju: 1,5 ure, vožnja z avtomobilom med posameznimi točkami: 15 minut ***SKUPAJ: 3 URE**

**Discover and explore the area of the Classical Karst,
known worldwide for its special landscape features.**

Notranjska – a part of the Classical Karst

Notranjska is a land of high plateaus, hills and fields. The area between the Loško and Cerkniško polje (Fields) is a typical transitional territory between the sink area of one polje and the spring area of the other. The Obrh Stream disappears in the Loško polje (Field) through the many sinkholes, and when water levels are higher it also sinks through the two entrances into the Golobina Cave. On the opposite side, near the karst springs of Cemun and Obrh, the Cerkniško polje (Field) is home to various wild animals and special plants that have adapted to the transition from water to dry meadows.

Starting point: The starting point of our journey is the village Dane in the municipality of Loška dolina, in front of the church St. Urban

When: Monday, September 12th 2022 at 9 AM

Length (km): on foot: **6 km**, by car: **3 km**

Duration: walk across the Loško polje and visit to the entrances of the Golobina Cave: 1, 25 hour, walk across the Cerkniško polje (Lake Cerknica): 1.5 hours, drive by car to individual locations: 0.25 hours ***TOTAL: 3 HOURS**

Difficulty: The trip is not difficult. It requires intermediate fitness levels and is suitable for children of 6 years and above. Walking trails run across flat, slightly undulating and varied terrain. Hiking shoes are mandatory.

»Raziščimo zanimivosti jam v okolici Križne jame«

Spoznejmo kraške procese in pojave, nastajanje jam ter v njih živeče živali.

Notranjske jame

Podzemne vode, ki se skrivajo globoko pod zemljo oblikujejo in ustvarjajo nenavadne skalne in sigove oblike. Številne podzemne jame v katerih so v preteklosti "bivali zmaji, čarownice in hudiči", so danes še eden redkih človeku neznanih prostorov na planetu Zemlja. Slovenija je po biotski pestrosti jamskih organizmov na vrhu v svetovnem merilu. Tudi v jami Mrzla jama pri Ložu živijo prave jamske živali, prilagojene na razmere v podzemlju. Poleg njih v jamah občasno živijo ali jame obiskujejo tudi druge živali, kot so netopirji, kune, sove, polhi.

Podali se bomo na pohod na katerem bomo spoznavali kraške pojave, s poudarkom na podzemnih jama. Osrednja točka bo Mrzla jama pri Ložu v kateri bomo spoznavali jamske živali, ki so pomembne tudi z vidika lokalnih posebnosti na območju Notranjske.

Izvedeli bomo zgodbo o izvoru imena jame ter raziskali njene kapniške posebnosti. Pokukali bomo tudi v Partizanski magacin, jami (spodmola) Martinovo in Turšičeve skednedco in se seznanili z načinom nastajanja jam, brezen, spodmolov, brezstropih jam in udornic.

"Explore the secret of caves near the Križna jama – The Cross cave"

Let's find out specifics of the karst processes and phenomena, the formation of underground caves and the animals living in them.

Caves in the Notranjska region

Karst waters hidden deep underground form and create unusual rock and sinter formations.

Numerous underground caves in which in the past "dragons, witches and devils" lived are today one of rare places unknown to man on the planet Earth. Slovenia is at the top of the world in terms of the biodiversity of cave organisms. There are also cave animals in the Mrzla jama (Cold cave) near the city of Lož adapted to the conditions of the underground. Other animals, such as bats, martens, owls and dormice, occasionally live in caves or visit caves.

We will go on a hike where we will learn about karst phenomena, with an emphasis on underground caves. The central point will be the Mrzla jama (Cold cave), where we will get to know cave animals, which are important in the Notranjska region. We will learn the story of the origin of the name of the cave and explore its stalactite features. We will also peek into Partizanski magacin cave, "Martin's and Turšič's skednedca" caves and find out how caves, abysses, roofless caves and sinkholes are formed.

Rapallo border

With the help of means of transport, we will travel and see the important cultural heritage of the time between the First and Second World Wars in the Javorniki hills and the Snežnik mountains, when the border between the Kingdom of Italy and Yugoslavia was here. Part of the route (about 1 hour walk) will also be on foot. We will learn about the activities that took place in the area of Javorniki and Snežnik between the wars, the remnants of these activities in the field - cultural and technical heritage (underground fortifications, bunkers, military barracks, anti-tank barriers, border stones) and stories and anecdotes preserved in this area over time as an intangible heritage.

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»Ne samo UNESCO dediščina v sekundarnih bukovih gozdovih na Snežniku«

Snežnik

ali Bela gora, kot so ga imenovali Rimljani, je vzpetina, ki leži na prehodu med Jadranskim morjem in evropsko celino. Snežniški gozdovi so velikanska sklenjena gozdna površina na prehodu iz primorskega sveta v notranjost Slovenije. Večina območja predstavlja dobro ohranjene sekundarne bukove gozdove. Manjši del območja predstavlja starodavne bukove gozdove s predeli prvinskih gozdov. Zaradi specifičnih rastiščnih razmer blizu morja in višine gore Snežnika bukev tu tvori zgornjo gozdno mejo in izpričuje moč preživetja v najbolj ekstremnih razmerah. *Leta 2017 je bilo to območje vpisano na seznam svetovne dediščine UNESCO.* V snežniških gozdovih je človek prisoten in jih preoblikuje že stoletja. Na poti bomo opazovali in raziskovali kraške pojave, ostanke delovanja ledenikov, posebne »snežniške pojave« ter kulturno krajino in kulturno dediščino sekundarnih bukovih gozdov Notranjske.

"Not only UNESCO heritage in secondary beech forests on Snežnik mountain"

Snežnik Mountain

or White Mountain, as the Romans called it, is a hill lying at the crossroads between the Adriatic Sea and the European continent. Snežnik forests are a huge closed forest area at the transition from the coastal world to the interior of Slovenia. Most of the area represents well-preserved secondary beech forests. A small part of the area is represented by ancient beech forests with areas of primary forests. Due to the specific habitat conditions near the sea and the height of the Snežnik mountain, the beech tree forms the upper forest border and testifies to the strength of survival in the most extreme conditions. In 2017, the area was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. People have been present in this forests for centuries and have been transforming them for centuries. Along the way, we will observe and explore karst phenomena, remnants of glacier activity, special "snow phenomena" and the cultural landscape and cultural heritage of the secondary beech forests of Notranjska.
